Annual Projects of the Junior Auxiliary of Pascagoula-Moss Point

“Kids Count” - This is our flagship program through which eighth-graders are counseled in appropriate decision making in the areas of drug and alcohol abuse, self-esteem, teen relationships, and career goals. The emphasis of the project is to make young people realize that the decisions they make today could impact them for the rest of their lives.

“INK”—Inspirational Notes for Kids - This is one of our newest projects in which we exchange monthly letters with young girls at Jackson Elementary School. The relationship established between the individual member and the girl provides the girl with emotional support, exercises her language and writing skills, and develops a trusting friendship between the participants. At the end of the school year, the participants meet at a special party to celebrate their new friendships!

Hope House - One night each month, members of JA bring dinner and dessert to the young people participating in the program at Hope House in Pascagoula. Additionally, we have volunteered to help provide Thanksgiving Dinner and Christmas gifts to the participants. (In 2006, JA members, past and present, provided Christmas gifts to 67 young people through this project!)

JA Day - This a day-long event through which elementary-aged children are introduced to arts. The program includes various activities to promote creativity. Additionally, the day includes games, face painting, and food.

Arts in the Schools - JA provides various cultural and art programs for area elementary schools, with an emphasis on “underserved” schools.

Headstart Readers - This monthly project brings JA members to the county Headstart Center to read to pre-school children, aiming at sparking an interest in reading in children. This project serves approximately 180 children a month.

School Outreach - This project addresses the needs of the local school systems—including providing school uniforms, “Socks for Tots,” and the “Teacher’s Pantry”—to ensure that local school children have all the needed supplies for their education.

Done in a Day - In these efforts we work in conjunction with other civic-oriented organizations to assist in one-day service projects—includes Salvation Army Bell Ringers, Jackson County Children’s Coalition Kid’s Time, American Heart Association’s Heart Walk, American Cancer Society’s Relay for Life, various United Way projects, etc.

The Junior Auxiliary of Pascagoula-Moss Point also participates in a number of other local community activities including the Sandra Eisler Summer Art Camp for Children, the Zonta Festival, Christmas by the River, and the Exceptional School.
